Plymouth Rally & Annual Race July 26th - 29th 2024 - Program

On FRIDAY 26th JULY As boats arrive, and moor up there will be plenty of opportunity to take lines, socialise and dress overall, if you can. After sharing BYO refreshments, crews can make their own arrangements to eat aboard, perhaps on coach roofs to facilitate further socialising, weather permitting. The Marina bar and restaurant, "Jolly Jacks", is an alternative - booking may be required. There is a Lidl supermarket about 20 minutes' walk away. It is also possible to dinghy over to the William Yard complex, should you wish (ask for a permit to park your dinghy at the Marina office). *Low Tide:16:23*

On SATURDAY 27th JULY There will be a skipper's briefing for the South West Area's **Annual Race** at 10:30, outside the Jolly Jack's bar. Sam Marshal, for the Plym YC, will be present. You will collect a number board to secure in your vessel's rigging, as instructed. The number board should be returned at the prize giving. **The Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions** should be read and understood. Starting first, at **13:00**, off the Mountbatten Pier race hut, the smaller boats in Class 1, will have a mass start. The remaining, larger, boats will start after their nominated intervals, from 13:10, in the form of a Timed Gate Start. All boats to have crossed the start by 13:45 to be placed. Racing will take place in the Sound.

On the **Saturday evening** there will be the **Prize Giving** at **18:30**, followed by a two-course **meal**, at "Jolly Jacks", restaurant in the marina, at 19:00. Draught ale and wine etc. can be purchased at the bar. *High Tide: 11:03 Low Tide:17:05*

On SUNDAY 28th JULY While some, may wish to move on, perhaps towards Fowey Classics, weather permitting, there should be time to **cruise, in company**, towards **Weir Quay**, where the café will be open to purchase a light lunch around highwater.
