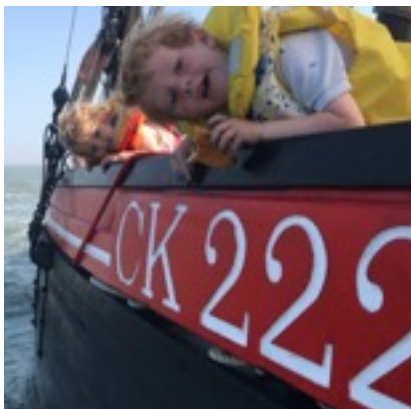

Two trophies were not awarded in 2018: Alan Hidden Trophy and Jolie Brise Trophy. Two new trophies were presented: the Oodta Cup and Tales of Sail Award.

The Cape Horn Trophy was awarded to Darryl Hughes, skipper of 'Maybird' for his magnificent achievement in completing the Volvo Round Ireland Race.

In recognition of their work in making the OGA55 event such a success, Tony & Sally Kiddle, were awarded the David Cade Memorial Trophy. The new award, Oodta Cup was presented to Eloisa Howlett for her exceptional seamanship as skipper of the Essex smack, 'Ellen'.

Vic Love won the Gaffers Globe for taking his 19' Golant Gaffer from her home near Plymouth to the Mediterranean.

Paddy Murphy and grandson Conor were awarded the Grumpy II Cups for their circumnavigation of Ireland in a 45', newly restored, 102-year old gaff ketch 'Aigh Vie'.
